## **“Tailoring Teens For Success” FACT SHEET—Q&A**

### **What is “Tailoring Teens for Success”?**

It's a 10-week curriculum that focuses on building character, promotes positive and critical thinking and teaches leadership and life skills.

### **Who is it for?**

“Tailoring Teens for Success” is open to girls ages 11-16. Enrollment is limited to 35 girls.

### **When is “Tailoring Teens for Success” held?**

The sessions are held for 10 consecutive Saturdays, 10am-1pm beginning September 6<sup>th</sup>-November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2008.

### **Where are the sessions held?**

Sessions are held at the University of Phoenix, University area campus, 10925 David Taylor Drive, Room 105, Charlotte, NC. (see calendar)

### **What are the sessions about?**

Each week, professionally-trained facilitators lead sessions that focus on a different topic. Topics range from self-esteem, to relationships, to etiquette, to career, to finance. A field trip is also included—a college tour. (see calendar for details).

### **What can girls expect at each session?**

Each girl receives a work notebook, a journal and is served a light breakfast. Girls exercise briefly before starting sessions, so comfortable attire is required.

### **What will girls need to bring for each session?**

Girls need to bring their notebook, their journal and any assignment given to them from the previous week. Girls will need to wear comfortable clothing.

### **What happens at the end of the curriculum?**

A graduation ceremony is held for girls who complete the curriculum and each girl receives a certificate and/or a special recognition award.

### **What are girls required to do to complete the curriculum?**

Each girl is required to attend and participate in a minimum of 8 sessions; each girl is required to complete the community service project assigned during the curriculum; each girl must commit to serving as a mentor or volunteer for the next curriculum session or during the following year's activities.

### **How much does it cost?**

The cost is \$50 per girl to enroll. **All payments are due by Friday, August 15<sup>th</sup>.** Payments can be made in cash or by money order to: Girl Talk Foundation, Inc. Mail or drop off to 801 E. Morehead Street, Suite 105, Charlotte, NC 28202. **CHECKS ARE NOT ACCEPTED.**
